

NZIMRT Encouragement Award

Nominations:

Any two NZIMRT members can nominate a person for the NZIMRT Encouragement Award. A nomination shall be submitted in writing to the Board with a motivation for the nomination.

Nominations will be assessed by a subcommittee of the Board consisting of: President, Vice President and Education Director.

Criteria for Assessment:

The nominee must be a minimum of three years post-graduation.

The nominee must have been a member of the NZIMRT for a minimum of three years and must be a member at the time of nomination.

Commitment to profession as demonstrated through involvement with the professional body.

May be demonstrated by the following:

- ❖ Participant at local regional NZIMRT meetings
- ❖ Supported the organisation of local regional meetings; study days or conferences
- ❖ Had involvement in a modality group
- ❖ Presented at any professional meeting
- ❖ Encourages workplace involvement and / or student membership of the NZIMRT
- ❖ Demonstrates an interest in future involvement with the professional body

Commitment to clinical practice and advancement of patient care demonstrated within the clinical practice environs.

May be demonstrated by the following:

- ❖ Identified interest in extended learning and practice opportunities
- ❖ Involved in the support of training & / or assessment of students
- ❖ Involvement with clinical leadership teams within the clinical environment – e.g. team member of group developing new techniques / practices / initiatives
- ❖ Presented individually or as part of a group within the workplace
- ❖ Involved in the development of patient care initiatives
- ❖ Clinical practice or clinical education is practiced at a high standard
- ❖ Team player
- ❖ Provides a quality, caring and professional service to patients / students and fellow staff members
- ❖ Roles of responsibility within the workplace are held beyond the daily workload

Commitment to the ongoing development of the medical imaging / therapy profession as demonstrated by involvement with education, continuing professional development and professional presentations – oral or written.

May be demonstrated by the following:

- ❖ Supports students in the workplace – formal / informal
- ❖ Beginning to demonstrate leadership within own team
- ❖ Evidence of own continuing professional development
- ❖ Published and / or presented locally
- ❖ May have or be studying towards additional qualifications
